
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OMAHA CORPORATE GAMES SUMMARY

What is the Omaha Corporate Games?

The Omaha Corporate Games is a company-based competition, taking place in the fall, that enables and supports teamwork, company pride and corporate wellness through healthy competition. There are multiple events offered including competitive, non-competitive and virtual events.

What is the purpose of the Omaha Corporate Games?

- To promote physical activity and overall fitness among employees of Nebraska businesses, municipalities, and government entities through competitive sports and recreational events.
- To provide companies with a platform to promote employee wellness, foster teamwork, and instill company pride.
- To provide a perk that companies can use for recruiting and retaining employees.

When does registration for the Omaha Corporate Games take place?

Company registration is open until the Games reach capacity at 50 companies. Early registration is encouraged to secure a spot.

What is the company's investment for the Omaha Corporate Games?

- \$2,000 until January 31
- \$2,500 until registration closes (mid-July)

Who is eligible to compete?

The Omaha Corporate Games is open to any company, municipality, government agency or department in Nebraska. Participation is for regular employees (full or part-time) and interns. Participants must be 18 years of age or older.

How large does a company have to be to participate in the Omaha Corporate Games?

Companies of all sizes can participate. Once registration is complete, companies are grouped into divisions based on their size. Companies with fewer than 75 employees can join forces with other small companies to compete as one team (combined total of employees cannot exceed 100).

When will I find out what division my company is in?

Divisions are based on the total number of local employees at each company. To ensure accurate placement, divisions will be assigned after registration closes and all participation is final.

How do employees sign up for events?

Once a company has registered, employees can use the <u>Omaha Corporate Games</u> <u>Dashboard</u> to view events and declare interest. For team sports and limited-capacity events, the Company Administrator or Sport Captain will determine who competes in each event.

What if an employee wants to enter multiple sports and events?

Employees are allowed to compete in multiple sports and events. For limited-roster events, the Company Administrator decides which employees will participate.

How many participants can a company have in each event?

Most in-person team events have limits on the number of teams and roster sizes. Specific limits for each event can be found on the <u>Sports</u> page. Most individual competitive and non-competitive events have no participant limit.

How do you win events?

Companies compete against others of similar size based on number of employees. Points are awarded to the top five finishers in each event based on a point system. These points accumulate throughout the Games to determine the overall winner in each division.

Are there company awards?

The company with the most points at the end of the Games will take home the Omaha Corporate Games Title Belt. One belt will be awarded per division. The top three companies in each division will also receive a plaque. Medals are given to participants of the top three teams in each division for most team sports, and Champion Banners are awarded to the top company in each event. Title belts, plaques, and banners will be presented to companies at their office following the conclusion of the Games.

Are companies required to have uniforms?

Companies are encouraged to be creative and provide a company t-shirt or jersey for their employees, but uniforms are not required for most events.

How can companies become sponsors?
